

# Terms and Conditions

Atlantis Leisure's 25<sup>th</sup> Birthday design a mascot competition, we're giving you the chance to design a mascots for future Atlantis events and 25<sup>th</sup> birthday celebrations.

1. Atlantis Leisure's 25<sup>th</sup> Birthday design a mascot competition to create a design for future Atlantis Leisure events (the "Competition") is open to all UK residents aged between 4 and 14 years of age on 16 June 2017.
  2. To enter the Competition entrants must:
    - Create an original design for the official mascot for Atlantis Community Leisure. This design will be made into a costume character to be worn during our respective events.
    - Submit an A4 drawing of their designs for the mascot and a written paragraph, no more than 4 lines long, explaining how they came up with their design.
  3. Entry is via the entry form which can only be downloaded from the **Atlantis Leisure's website** or collected from reception.
  4. If using a computer programme to design an entry, the design must still be all the entrant's own work. Materials such as clip art or photographs/internet images will disqualify the entry.
  5. The entry must be the entrant's own original work and not defame nor breach any copyright or contain anything that could be deemed offensive.
  6. All submissions must include the entrant's: name, age, date of birth, address including postcode, parent/guardian's name and a contact telephone number which can be filled in on the appropriate sections of the website entry form. Entrants should ask their parent/guardian's permission to enter the Competition and ensure that they have read the terms and conditions. This must be confirmed by completing the tick box on the entry form.
  7. All entrants must enter the Competition by submitting their design and entry form to either their school or Atlantis Leisure reception with the suggested donation of £1 per entry.
  8. Entries must be **RECEIVED by Friday 16 June 2017**. Late, incomplete, illegible entries or entries with insufficient postage will be disqualified. Atlantis Leisure will not be able to return entries.
  9. By submitting an entry for the Competition, the entrant's parent/guardian are deemed to have given consent for the entry to be published free of charge by the Oban Times and Atlantis Community Leisure in all media, including print and internet, for all purposes as it wishes. We may wish to display entries containing an entrant's name, age and town but please inform us if you don't want this to happen.
  10. All entries will be judged in the first instance by members of the Atlantis Leisure 25<sup>th</sup> Birthday team. This first judging panel will decide which entries should be put forward to the second stage of judging. The first judging round will select the 5 best entries for each of the following age categories:
    - **Category 1: Entrants aged 3-5**
    - **Category 2: Entrants aged 6-8**
    - **Category 3: Entrants aged 9-12**
  11. 15 entries in total will go through from the first round of judging to the second round of judging.
  12. The second judging stage will look at the 5 best entries for each age category (15 entries in total) and with a Facebook vote. From the 15 entries, the top entry in each age category (three entries in total) will go forward to the final judging panel. From the top three entries the winner will be chosen and the runners up will be ranked in order of merit.
- Criteria**
13. All entries will be judged against the following criteria:

- **Characters** - mascot must be a character and have a name – Your mascot must work well in Atlantis and enjoys all the activities you can do in Atlantis.
- **Original** – The designs must be unique and they must not replicate an existing mascot design.
- **Design** - The mascots must love being active and be excited to come to all our Atlantis events.
- **Creative** - The designs must be innovative, imaginative and bold so that they stand out.

**14. The prizes consist of: 1st Prize: 1 Winner**

The winning competition design will be turned into the official mascot for Atlantis Community Leisure

**Top Runners-Up (x 2)**

The 2 top runners up will each receive a month's free junior membership.

**15.** Atlantis Leisure may need to make minor reasonable modifications to the winning designs, however the designs which feature as the official Atlantis Leisure mascot shall recognisably be the winning designs of the Competition.

**16.** The prizes will be as stated. The prizes cannot be transferred and there is no cash alternative.

**17.** The judges' decision as to the winner is final. No correspondence relating to the Competition will be entered into.

**18.** The Atlantis Leisure reserves the right to cancel the Competition or change any of these rules at any stage if deemed necessary in its opinion or if circumstances arise outside of its control. Any such changes will be duly communicated.

**19.** The parent/guardian of an applicant is deemed to have accepted these terms and conditions when consenting to the application of the relevant entrant.
